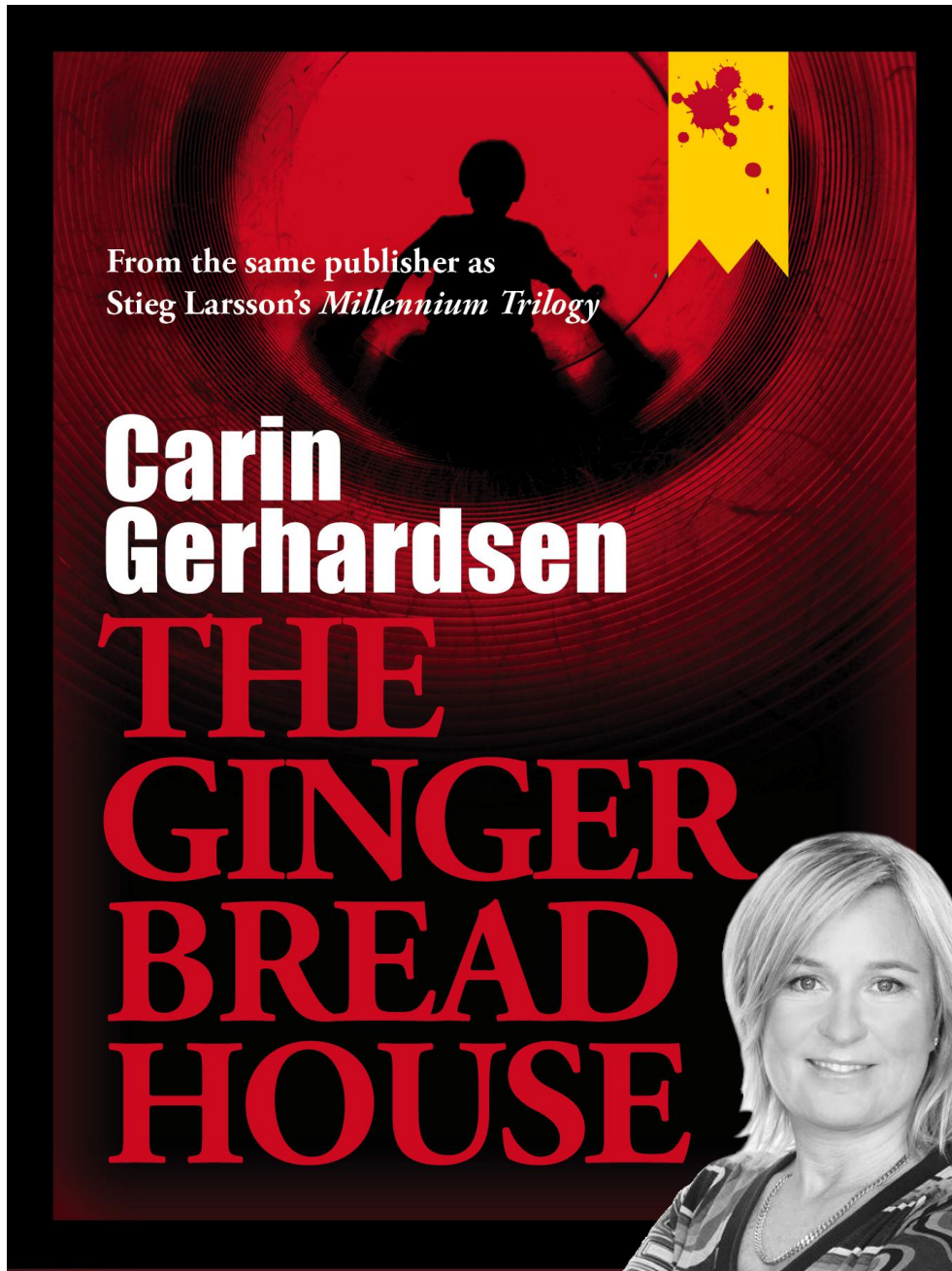

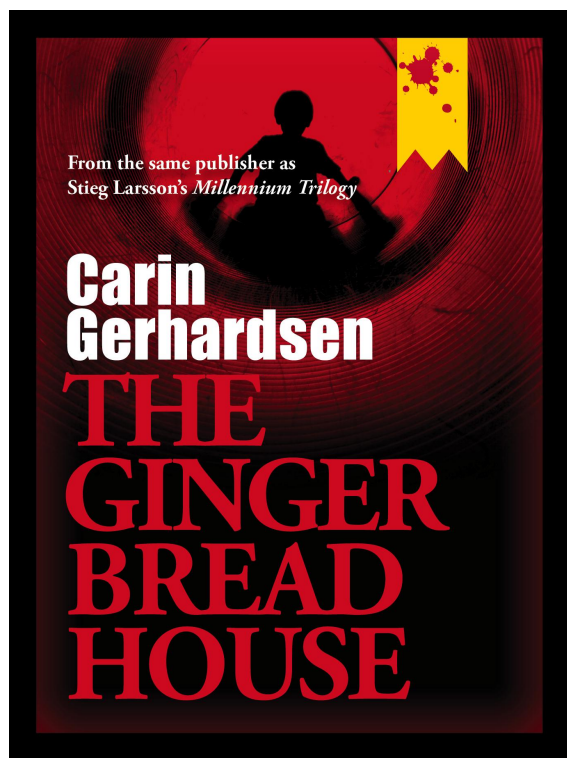

The issue of schoolyard bullying among young children lends itself to the premise and various scenes of this story, which is based on some of Gerhardsen's own cruel childhood experiences.

Known for thrillers with taut, intelligently calculated plots and unexpected twists and turns, Gerhardsen's background as an educated mathematician has been of importance to her writing. Her books are often compared to the HBO TV series *The Wire*, and her authorship to the Swedish writing team of police procedurals, Maj Sjöwall and Per Wahlöö.
